

303rd BG(H) Combat Mission No. 2

18 November 1942

Target: U-Boat Pens, St. Nazaire, France

Crews Dispatched: 21

Length of Mission: 6 hours, 36 minutes

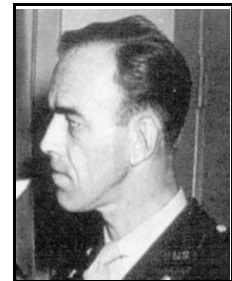
Bomb Load: 10 x 500 lbs H.E. M43 bombs

Enemy Aircraft Claims: 1 Destroyed, 4 Probables, 3 Damaged

Ammo Fired: 12,138 rounds

Bombing Altitude: 19,400 feet

For the Group's second mission, orders were received to bomb La Pallice, France. This order was changed during the early morning, but the message was not delivered to the proper persons until after the briefing. This was too late to change targets and still send well-informed crews on combat missions. Wing Headquarters was contacted and permission was given to proceed with the first order.

Col. **Wallace** would lead this mission, flying with Lt. **Ruppe**. The 359th BS was led by Maj. **Romig** and Lt. **Stouse**. Capt. **Lyle** and Maj. **Callaway** were lead aircraft for the 360th BS, but it had one 358th BS aircraft and crew under its command. Maj. **Sheridan** and Lt. **Stockton** took the lead for the 427th BS.

Twenty-one B-17s took off at 1025, went to the start point, and then direct to the target. The return trip was made around the Brest peninsula. Two planes had returned early due to mechanical difficulties. Following another Bomb Group to the target, the 303rd BG(H) attacked the secondary target, St. Nazaire, France at 1222 by mistake, at an altitude of 19,400 feet. The group had veered over 100 miles off course.

Intense heavy flak was encountered over the target area. The flak was mostly inaccurate for the height. Aircraft #41-24558, *Hunga Dunga*, experienced slight damage. A formation of 18-20 FW-190s attacked the 303rd BG 18 miles off Cape Frehel, France. The attack continued for 20 minutes. Sgt. Kenneth J. **Kurtenbach**, tail gunner on #41-24602, *Yardbird*, 360th BS, claimed destruction of an enemy aircraft. It was seen to turn to its side with smoke coming from its engine. Sgt. **Kurtenbach** fired several bursts into the FW-190's belly and flames were seen coming from the fuselage. It was out of control as it went into the clouds. An additional four aircraft were claimed as probably and three damaged. Three men were slightly wounded by flak.

Many hits were made on the dock installations at St. Nazaire, although it took a considerable amount of time to convince an unbelieving Col. **Wallace** that the Group had bombed the wrong target. Three planes landed at Chelveston, all others returned to Molesworth. Following the mission, sixteen of the Group's B-17s were out of commission due to flak and mechanical difficulties. This was a better record than the first mission, but the Group had a long way to go to become war veterans.
