## 303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 68

7 September 1943

Target: Evere Airdrome at Brussels, Belgium

Crews Dispatched: 14

Length of Mission: 4 hours, 35 minutes

Bombing Altitude: 24,000 ft

Bomb Load: 12 x 500 lb H.E. M-43 G.P. bombs

Ammo Fired: 5,330 rounds

igh Group of the 103 PBCW was comprised of a composite Group provided by the 102 PBCW. Both 303rd BG(H) Squadrons were forced to fly through an overcast sky to form their Groups. Lt. **Baker in** 358BS #42-29664 *Jersey Bounce*, *Jr.* aborted the mission when he was unable to find the formation after climbing through the overcast.


All aircraft released their 500-lb. M-43 bombs on seeing their respective Group lead B-17s drop their bombs. Bombing results were reported as good. Meager, inaccurate flak was reported. 1Lt. **Casello's** Squadron saw approximately 20 enemy fighters with four tail attack encounters. Lt. **Mattison's** Squadron reported seeing three enemy fighters with no attacks. The P-47s provided excellent cover. There were no casualties and one aircraft sustained minor damage.

Colonel Stuart **Porter** of VIII Bomber Command flew as a passenger on Lt. **Mattison's** *The '8' Ball MK II.* He remarked, "The target was hit and smashed badly. There were a few fighters, but the P-47s took care of them. There was some flak but it didn't bother any of us." Lt. **Mattison** confirmed Col. **Porter's** version when he said, "It was a perfect raid. Just swarms of P-47s and they were really working and doing a beautiful job. The bombing was perfect."

Capt. Glynn F. **Schumake**, 303rd BG(H) Operations Officer, flew as co-pilot with Lt. **Casello** in *Satan's Workshop*. He remarked, "We really did that target up good today. The weather was perfect. You could see for miles. We had a couple of fighters that made a direct attack, but not too eagerly. The P-47s took care of everything." S/Sgt. Glenn **Allen**, *Luscious Lady's* ball turret gunner said, "It was just a good ride today. If it hadn't been for the P-47s, we might have been kicked around a bit. They are doing a swell job of protection." S/Sgt. A.C. **Santella**, waist gunner on *Walleroo* 359BS, got a good look at the target after the bombing run. He noted, "We really plastered the target today. Smoke and flames were shooting out from all of the buildings on the field."

Several men completed their 25 mission operational tours. S/Sgt. Frank M. **Matthews**, ball turret gunner on *War Bride* 358BS who has three enemy fighters to his credit said, "It was a swell raid to finish up on. Now I hope that they send me to the Pacific area to get a crack at the Japs." Lt. Burt J. **Cardwell**, pilot of *Flak Wolf* 427BS, buzzed the control tower on his return signifying his final mission. He also threw out a white towel. After landing he remarked, "Not much to it. Five or ten fighters and a little flak. That's all there was." Lt. Edwin **Lamme**, bombardier on *Flak Wolf* calmly added, "No use sweating

'em out. Easy raid. Lots of fighter cover and good bombing." Lt. James R. **McConnen**, navigator on *Star Dust* 358BS said, "Not much to talk about on this one, but I'm glad to be finished for a while."
