

## 303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 102

30 January 1944

Target: Twin Engine Fighter Production Center,  
Brunswick, Germany (PFF Bombing)

Crews Dispatched: 36

Length of Mission: 6 hours, 25 minutes

Bomb Load: 21 or 42 x 65 lb M47A1 Incendiaries

Bombing Altitude: A Group, 24,400 ft; B Group, 25,300 ft

Ammo Fired: 8,030 rounds

One aircraft in each of the two 303rd BG(H) formations aborted:  
#42-5052 *Mizpah*, 427BS (**Hoeg**), had high oil temperature.  
#42-31583 *Clover Leaf*, 358BS (**Clark**), had a failed supercharger.

All Group aircraft carried M-47A1 65-lb. incendiary bombs. The "A" Group bombed from 24,400 feet and the "B" from 25,300 feet. Both dropped their bombs on the PFF aircraft signal.

Meager and inaccurate flak was experienced at several points along the route. P-38, P-47 and P-51 fighter support was excellent. From 25 to 40 enemy aircraft were seen. The "A" Group had no direct enemy aircraft attacks and "B" Group had only one vicious attack. Groups had dense, persistent contrails over 25,000 feet that affected visibility and formation flying. All aircraft returned safely with no casualties.

"Clouds and contrails gave us more trouble than anything else," Capt. **Schulstad** reported. "At times it was so thick we couldn't even see the flak. Fighters didn't bother us, but our tail gunner said that the Group behind us was really catching hell." "It was fairly easy for us today," Lt. **Heller** said. "We had loads of P-47s and P-51s along. It sure looked good to see wave after wave of Forts going in and out of the target area. Maj. **Cole** said, "We didn't see very much. The weather was terrible, with thick contrails. We had a few fighter attacks, but they weren't persistent and didn't come in too close. Our fighter escort was really good and they took care of us." Lt. Thomas **Quinn**, Maj. **Cole's** co-pilot, said his Group was lucky. "The Group behind us got a real going over. I didn't see them, but I heard them trying to contact our fighters on the radio to give them cover." Lt. **Halpin**, pilot-tail gunner said, "Some German fighters were trying to get in at our tail, but they were concentrating mostly on the Group behind us. I really felt sorry for them."

S/Sgt. Simeon **Oxendine**, waist gunner, was enthusiastic about the fighter support and said, "ME-110s tried to team up in groups of three and swing in to attack our formation, but the P-47s always broke them up before they even got started." T/Sgt. J.E. **Dennis**, radio operator said the mission could have been rough if it hadn't been for the fighter cover. "It was rough for us for a minute. The fighters were just starting to make their attacks when the P-47s came up and drove them away. I saw three Forts in the Group behind us go down. The clouds and contrails were alive with German fighters." S/Sgt. Leo R. **McConaghy**, waist gunner on the Fortress "Sky Duster" thought that the bombs hit

something big. "We could see black smoke coming up through the clouds when we were 60 miles away on the way home." His 13th mission turned out to be a rough one for S/Sgt. Albert **Ledley**, waist gunner on *Old Glory*. He said, "We had to feather our No. 3 engine when we were still over England. I thought we'd have to abort, but instead of that we dropped half of our bombs in the channel so we could keep up with the formation and went in to give 'Jerry' hell with what we had left."

The Fortress *Knockout Dropper* completed its 64th mission and *The Duchess* returned safely from its 52nd mission.

### **From the Journal of Vern L. Moncur, 359th BS Pilot**

#### **MISSION #8**

Date: January 30, 1944

Target: Brunswick, Germany

Altitude: 27,000 feet

Plane: M-629 "Connecticut Yankee"

Position: No. 2, Lead Squadron, High Group

This was our second mission in two days, but we got along alright. We flew another Squadron's plane because our plane was in the hangar for a new wing and patch-up job.

We had an excellent escort of P-47s, P-51s and P-38s on this trip. The flak wasn't as accurate on our group as usual, though other groups were getting a lot of it. We did get enough of it to keep us sweating it out and to give us a few holes. We saw quite a few enemy planes - ME-110s, ME-210s, FW-190s and ME-109s. The ball turret gunner, S/Sgt. Hein, nailed one of the FW-190s as it made a pass at another Fort in a lower squadron and then peeled off in our direction.

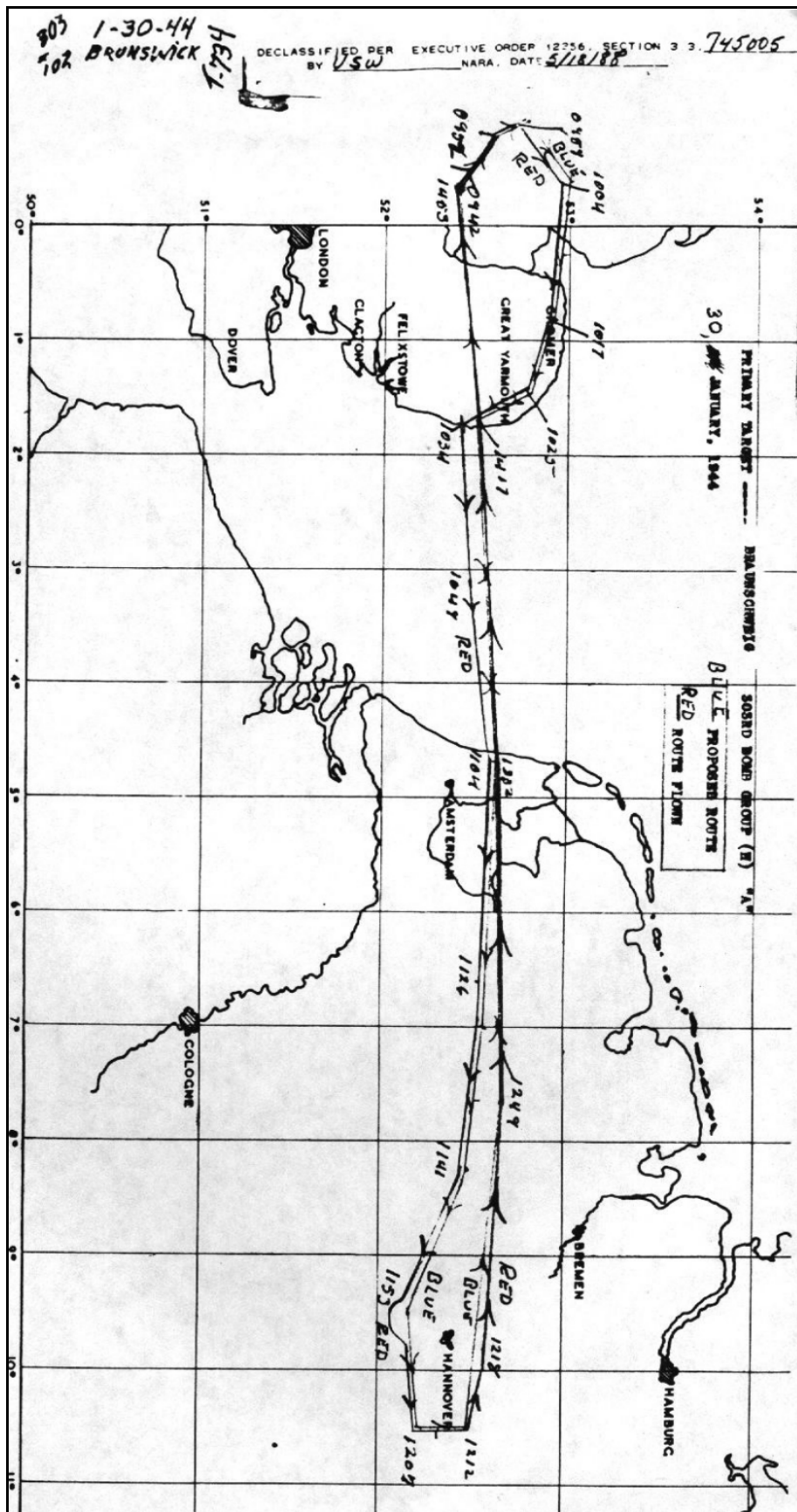
On this mission we carried 21 general purpose one-hundred pound bombs. These bombs were fire-bombs as well as anti-personnel bombs. We had to carry one bomb bay gasoline tank in order to get the necessary range. We ran into a lot of very persistent vapor trails at altitude on this mission. that made the fighter danger more probable and we had to be doubly watchful of "bandits." Luckily, we did not have any direct attacks, though several German planes skirted the bomber formation. They kept pretty close to the clouds so that they could get into them for cover if jumped by one of our P-47s or P-51s. There was no injury to the crew, and very light battle damage to the plane.
