

## 303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 158

23 May 1944

Target: Saarbrucken, Germany (PFF)

Crews Dispatched: 26 + 2 PFF

Length of Mission: 6 hours, 45 minutes

Bomb Load: 12 x 500 lb G.P. bombs

Bombing Altitude: 25,000 & 24,000 ft

Ammo Fired: 2,310 rounds

Twenty-six B-17s, including four spares, took off to bomb the Nancy/Essey airdrome in France. The secondary target, if the primary target could not be visually bombed, was the marshalling yards at Saarbrucken, Germany. Poor take-off visibility caused some assembly difficulties.

Three of the spares turned back and one filled in for one of the two B-17s that returned early. #42-97546 *Idaliza*, 460BS-E (**Christian**), lost formation over the Channel. #42-31483 *Bonnie B*, 359BS-P (**Sirany**), had a blown piston ring. The crew took off in a standby B-17, but could not catch the formation.

At the primary target, there were 8/10 clouds, prohibiting visual bombing. The secondary target at Saarbrucken was bombed by PFF. Twenty aircraft dropped 237 500-lb. G.P. M43 bombs from 25,000 and 24,000 feet. One aircraft jettisoned twelve 500-lb. bombs.

There were reports of five to eight enemy ME-109s. One made a pass at the Group. Three aircraft sustained damage from the fighter attack. Friendly fighter support was good except for the brief gap when the attack occurred. Flak was meager to moderate. Chaff seemed to be effective since no aircraft sustained flak damage. All aircraft returned safely with no casualties.

Capt. George T. **Mackin** said, "It wasn't too bad. We had two attacks by a group of FW-190s about an hour apart, but they didn't do any damage and the P-51s took care of them in a hurry. Even the Saarbrucken flak gunners seemed to be taking the day off for a change."

There were two gunner claims on enemy aircraft. S/Sgt. Roy D. **Harvey** (#42-97405) claimed and ME-109 as probable, but it was not confirmed as a claim. Sgt. Armin C. **Held** (#42-38050) claimed a damaged ME-109 and was credited with a probable.

***MY CREW DIDN'T WANT TO GO BACK — AND  
NEITHER DID I — SAARBRUCKEN AGAIN!***  
**Ed Miller's Memories and Recollections**

Saarbrucken wasn't the target, but when we began to close in on the Nancy/Essey Airdrome, our primary, it was covered by 8/10 cloud cover. So we headed for the secondary, which was Saarbrucken. My crew and I didn't want to go on to Saarbrucken. But we went, as I was leading the Low Squadron of the Low Group which was led by Captain George Mackin. Lt/Col. Lewis E. Lyle was the Air Commander of the 41st Combat Wing and flew with the 303rd Bomb Group's A formation and 1Lt Donald Stouli.


My crew was the Cecchini crew and they vividly recalled getting shot so bad that they had to go down on the deck with two engines to try to make it back to England. A bad crash landing put a couple of the crew in the hospital, including 2Lt Anthony Cecchini their pilot.

We were hit twice by two separate attacks by FW-190s and Me-109s. Luckily, the anti-aircraft crews had taken the day off, or maybe it was because we didn't have to drag over the Marshalling Yards for the second time, that we didn't experience too much in the way of flak.

Again, today we had very poor visibility for our take-off and landing at Molesworth but every one got off and back without any casualties.
