

303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 171

5 June 1944

Target: Gun Emplacements at Azeville, Lessay & Caen, France

Crews Dispatched: 38

Length of Mission: 5 hours, 20 minutes

Bomb Load: 12 x 500 lb G.P. & 5 S.A.P. bombs

Altitude: 25,000 ft, 24,500 ft, 25,000 ft

Ammo Fired: 0 rounds

Thirty-eight aircraft, including three spares, took off for the fifth time in June on a pre-invasion support mission. One PFF aircraft from the 305BG flew as the lead B-17 in the 303BG-A formation. The three spares returned when no regular aircraft returned early.

303BG-A (Lead): Ten B-17s dropped 143 500-lb. S.A.P. bombs. They flew with the 91BG and bombed its target at Azeville from 25,000 feet. The aircraft made three bomb runs using AFCE which worked satisfactorily. Results were not known.

303BG-B (Low): Twelve aircraft dropped 132 500-lb. G.P. and 12 500-lb. S.A.P. bombs on the Lessay landing ground as a target of opportunity after three bomb runs on the primary target. The bombs, dropped from 24,500 feet, hit short and left of the hangar buildings. The AFCE equipment did not operate correctly and caused violent turns.

303BG-C (High): Twelve aircraft dropped 132 500-lb. G.P. M43 bombs on an airfield near Carentan. Four bomb runs were made and bombs were dropped left of the target area from 25,000 feet.

There were 4/10 to 6/10 clouds in the target area. Although visibility was good, the clouds interfered with the bombing. No enemy aircraft were seen and flak was meager and inaccurate. All aircraft returned undamaged with no casualties.

5 June 1944 - Air Offense, Europe Battle Ends:

The Air Offensive, Europe battle, which started on 4 July 1942, ended on 5 June 1944.

5 June 1944 - Use of the Word "Ship" to Designate Aircraft Prohibited:

The following letter from Headquarters USSAFE, dated 5 June 1944, file 452.1, was received for information of all personnel concerned:

Memorandum No. W 95-44; WD, 13 May 1944, subject:

"Designation of Aircraft":

1. Use of the word "ship" to designate aircraft has led to serious confusion between personnel of the Army and personnel of the Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard.

2. All Army personnel will discontinue use of the word "ship" to designate aircraft.

IT'S GETTING CLOSE TO INVASION TIME

from the book "25 Milk Runs" by Richard R. "Dick" Johnson



"Cherbourg Peninsula, France," my diary read. "Heavy gun batteries on invasion coast. Made 3 bomb runs. Meager flak, no damage, four tenths cloud cover on target. Saw hundreds of ships on English coast. Things may pop open very soon now."

This was to be a short mission, so we traded fuel for bombs. Each B-17 was loaded with sixteen 500-pound, semi-armor-piercing bombs. We took off at 6:15 am with 12 scheduled B-17s and one spare, which would fill in if there was an abort from our group. Since there were no aborts, the spare returned before reaching enemy territory. We departed England at Selsey Bill at 24,500 feet, and headed to our Initial Point in the channel, which was determined by LORAN. This was a less sophisticated version of modern LORAN (Long Range Navigation) using only two radio stations. This could take us within a quarter mile or so of our destination. Modern LORAN uses three stations.

Due to clouds, we tried three times to hit the primary target, each time returning to our IP in the channel, to no avail. Just ahead of our last attempt, was a heavy gun emplacement next to a landing strip. They received the attention of the nine aircraft in our part of the group. They received 144 semi-armor piercing, 500-pound bombs, just because the weather was bad elsewhere.

After bombing, we let down over the channel, through clouds, and crossed the English coast at Portland Bill at 2,700 feet. We flew a direct course to our base at Molesworth, arriving just before noon.

Over the target area, there was moderate flak in several places, but none close enough to damage any of the B-17s of our group. Only two fighter planes were seen, and they were both ours. We were in the air four and a half hours, with thirty-five minutes over enemy territory.

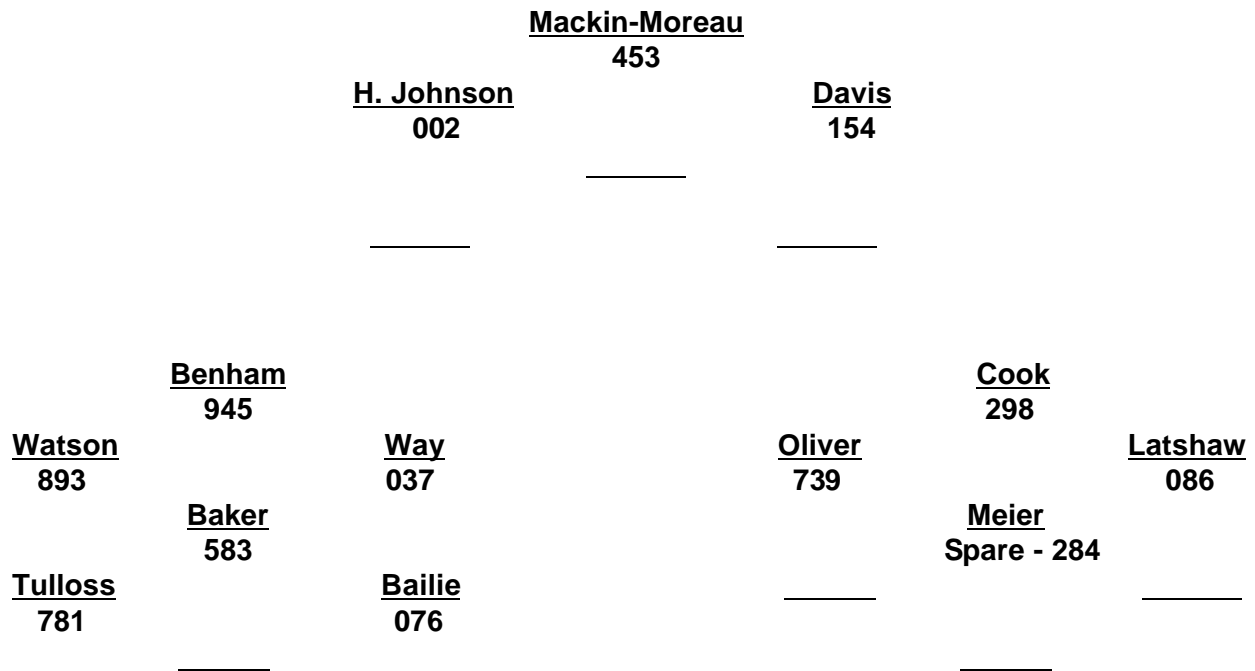
