

## 303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 175

7 June 1944

Target: Road Junctions at Flers & Conde-Sur-Noireau, France

Crews Dispatched: 38

Length of Mission: 5 hours, 20 minutes

Bomb Load: 6 x 1,000 lb G.P. & 12 x 500 lb G.P. bombs

Bombing Altitudes: 21,300 ft & 21,200 ft

Ammo Fired: 0 rounds

Road junctions near Flers and Conde-Sur-Noireau, France were the target. Thirty-eight 303rd BG B-17s took off to attack. The two spare aircraft returned as ordered.

Weather over the targets was 10/10 cumulus with small breaks. No enemy aircraft or flak was encountered. Crews reported seeing only a few friendly fighters. There were no casualties and all aircraft returned to Molesworth.

The 41st CBW-A formation of the 303rd BG(H) dropped 108 1,000-lb. M44 bombs on the primary target. Bombing results could not be observed. The 303BG-A lead aircraft had no Gee-H equipment, so bombs were dropped on the 379 lead B-17 from 21,300 feet.

The 41st CBW-B 303rd BG(H) formation dropped 174 500-lb. M43 and 42 500-lb. RDX bombs from 21,200 feet. Two aircraft returned with their bombs when the bomb release equipment malfunctioned. One crew spotted bombs through a small hole in the clouds hitting the town.



## **SUPPORTING OUR GROUND TROOPS**

from the book "25 Milk Runs" by Richard R. "Dick" Johnson

My diary for June 7th reads: "Cherbourg again. Invasion coast. Bombed German escape route. Target seven tenths covered. Used PFF method of bombing. No opposition from Nazis. Big operations. We are wholly supporting ground troops."

Beiser and I were assigned to the B-17 with the tail number 42-39875 named "Buzz Blonde." I would ultimately fly twelve missions in this plane. Each of the eighteen B-17s of our group was loaded with six 1,000-pound bombs to be delivered to a road junction near the invasion coast close to Conde Sur Noireau in western France. Eighteen other B-17s from our field were loaded with 500-pound bombs which were dropped on a road and railroad junction near Flers, France. Two of our aircraft failed to bomb because of malfunctions. Due to overcast at the target, we bombed by radar from an average altitude of 21,000 ft. Our "Buzz Blonde" was assigned position number three in the 427th squadron. This is just behind and to the left of the lead plane of our squadron.

Although the target area was totally clouded over except for very small holes, one crew reported bombs exploding in the target area, which could be seen during one of the brief openings.

We were over enemy territory for forty minutes, but saw no flak or German fighters. We saw a few friendly fighters above the clouds that were our escorts. We could only get occasional glimpses of the invasion activity.

I might explain to the reader that our group was capable of putting forty B-17s in the air at any given mission, and on one mission actually put up sixty, but since a group of that size would be cumbersome, we always made two groups which we called the 41st combat wing "A" group, and 41st combat wing "B" group.

On this particular day, the "B" planes bound for Flers, took off starting at 0931 and ending ten minutes later with nineteen aircraft in the air at 0941. Without a break, our "A" group took off between 0941 and 0954. Each group had a spare, but since there were no aborts on this mission, they both returned before reaching enemy territory, and thus got no credit for a mission. Our route to the target took us due south, although we did a slight dog-leg to the west of London and headed to France and arrived just out of flak range of Le Havre. As we approached the target at 21,300 ft. indicated, (21,000 actual) the wind was 63 miles per hour from 340 degrees, giving us a left drift of 18 degrees. Our indicated air speed of 150 mph gave us a true airspeed of 208 mph and a ground speed of 207 mph at the target according to readings from the Norden bomb sight.

The outside air temperature was a relatively mild, minus 7 degrees Fahrenheit. Bombs were away at 1208 p.m. and we returned to base, arriving at 1432 with all planes on the ground by 1503. Each aircraft had carried 1,700 gallons of gasoline for this five hour and twenty minute mission.
