

303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 176

8 June 1944

Target: Marshalling Yards & Railroad Bridge
at Orleans, France

Crews Dispatched: 48

Length of Mission: 6 hours, 20 minutes

Bomb Load: 6 x 1,000 lb G.P. bombs

Bombing Altitude: 20,500 ft

Thirty-six B-17s from the 358BS, 360BS and 427BS of the 303BG(H) took off to attack the railroad marshalling yards at Orleans, France. Two aircraft returned early:
#42-31583 *Clover Leaf*, 358BS-C (Lt. **Watson**) - No. 1 engine trouble
#42-31997 (*No Name*), 360BS-F (Lt. **Long**) - failed to join the formation

Thirty-four aircraft attacked the primary target, dropping 199 1,000-lb. G.P. M44 bombs. There were 6/10 clouds with a break over the target. The 303BG-A bombardier, Capt. **McCormick**, was unable to make proper drift corrections on his bombsight. This caused bombs to hit on the left of the target. 1Lt. **Wilson**, low Group bombardier, made a second bomb run. It was a short run with poor formation resulting in a poor hit pattern. The high Group bombardier, 2Lt. **Merz**, reported that bombs hit some large buildings to the left of the target.

Twelve B-17s from the 359BS, flying with the 41st CBW-D high Group, attacked the railroad bridge at Orleans, France. Bombardier 2Lt. **Hogan** laid a perfect bomb pattern with excellent results from 20,500 feet with 1,000-lb. bombs. No enemy aircraft were spotted, no flak occurred, and all aircraft returned safely to Molesworth.

KNOCKING OUT THE GERMAN TRAIN TRACKS
from the book "25 Milk Runs" by Richard R. "Dick" Johnson

Diary: "Orleans, France (South of Paris). Marshaling yards supplying Germans for anti-invasion. Weather over continent is still pretty bad, but seems to be improving. Encountered no opposition. Six, one-thousand pound bombs."

This day we were to try to blow up the train tracks and the rolling stock carrying war goods to the front lines. We also hoped to drop a railroad bridge into the rubble.

Beiser and I were again assigned to the "Buzz Blonde" and our crew was complete. Sgt. Gorchesky, our radio man, missed yesterday's mission with us because his radio expertise was needed in our squadron's lead plane. But he was back with us today.

Our assembly was modified from plan because of two cloud layers. We finally assembled the group between these two layers. We flew thirty-six aircraft in three groups on this mission, taking off from 0431 to 0522 and were all back on the ground before noon, having largely wasted the mission because of a problem with the Norden Bomb Sight in the lead plane. We did visual bombing with an eleven minute bomb run, but in the last minute and a half the bombardier discovered that he needed two more degrees of drift correction. As he tried to crank in the correction, nothing happened, so he tried to crank in more turns with no results. He then decided to turn the mission over to the deputy lead to do another bomb run. His decision was too late however, as the Norden sight released the bombs and all the other eleven planes dropped in unison. Our bombs struck even with the target, but too far to the left by at least five hundred feet, destroying some large unknown buildings. We later learned that something was against the drift knob with enough pressure to prevent the corrections from being made. It was probably the bombardier's parachute harness that caused the malfunction, since the sight checked out fine at the repair shop.

Hogan was the hero of the day. The 359th squadron which held the high group position rescued the mission when the eleven planes of that group laid a perfect pattern on the railroad bridge. Lt. Hogan was the bombardier of the day for that feat.

The low group did just as badly as our group's effort. They had to make a second pass at the target and had a short bomb run. Some aircraft were still jockeying into their positions when bombs were away. Some of the planes were in slight banking positions which tossed their bombs to one side making a poor pattern. Some days it just doesn't pay to get up.

The lead plane in our squadron, the 427th, was called "Shoo Shoo Baby" after the song by the Andrews Sisters. Nearly every group had an aircraft with that name. The 360th squadron's lead plane was named "Sack Time" after our favorite indoor sport in those days. The lead plane of the 358th squadron was "Princess Pat," with the usual seductive nose art. Hogan's hero was "Heller's Angel," flying lead in the other 360th formation.
