

303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 179

13 June 1944

Target: Airdrome at Evreux, France

Crews Dispatched: 40

Length of Mission: 5 hours, 20 minutes

Bomb Load: 500 lb G.P. M-43 & 250 lb G.P. M-57 bombs

Bombing Altitudes: 21,800 ft & 21,000 ft

Ammo Fired: 0 rounds

Three of the 40 aircraft taking off again to attack an airfield returned early:

#42-31432 *Old Glory*, 360BS (Lt. **Johnston**) - prop governor failure.

#42-102411 *Miss Lace*, 427BS (Lt. **Mitchell**) - No. 2 engine failure.

#42-31224 *Hell in the Heavens*, 358BS (Lt. **Vaughn**) - airspeed indicator out.

No enemy aircraft were seen and no flak was encountered. Almost a solid undercast existed until reaching the target, where skies were clear with unlimited visibility. One bombardier said, "We bombed through the only hole in the clouds in Europe."

Thirty-seven aircraft dropped a total of 190 500-lb. G.P. M43 and 304 250-lb. G.P. M57 bombs from 21,800 and 21,000 feet with excellent results; both of the airfield's runways were rendered unserviceable.

All aircraft returned to England with two landing at Bassingbourne. There were no casualties and no aircraft damage.

ELIMINATING THE GERMAN FIGHTERS

from the book "25 Milk Runs" by Richard R. "Dick" Johnson

The weather was finally clear over the target for today's mission, and opposition could nearly always be expected on clear days. We were to bomb the airdrome at Evreux (pronounced Ev-Row) in order to harass the German fighter planes stationed there. We had missed a mission on June 12 because of maintenance problems with our "Buzz Blonde." A B-17 with no name was shot down on the 12th when it was hit by a direct flak burst at the left wing root, and another directly in the bomb-bay, while the bomb-bay doors were open for a drop one minute later. The aircraft burst into flame and disintegrated. Only the tail gunner survived.

Today, we were assigned the number two position next to the second flight plane flown by 1Lt Charles R. Allen. The Squadron Lead plane was flown by 1Lt Fred E. Mitchell and the Deputy Lead by 2nd Lt Wilford T. Means. Before we reached the French coast, the plane flown by the leader, Lt. Mitchell, had to abort due to number two engine failure. Lt. Means moved up to the number one position, and our spare flown by Lt. Lehman moved into the formation to complete the mission. Of the forty planes we put up that day, only three aborted: our 426th squadron's "Miss Lace" in which I would fly my last mission, flown by Lt. Mitchell; "Old Glory" from the 360th Squadron; and "Helen Heavens" from the 385th Squadron.

We flew to France after climbing through a solid overcast and hit the coast headed toward the French town of Amiens, but turned south in a feint to Paris, and finally to the target which was a few miles southwest of Paris. We each carried 18 250-pound, general purpose bombs, and 1700 gallons of gasoline to hit the airfield.

Just before we got to the target, the skies cleared, and the visibility became unlimited. We could see the target from the initial point and the bombardier did a superb job, putting the pattern of bombs across the airfield, ruining both runways. The lead bombardier said that we bombed the target through the only hole in the clouds over Europe. We saw flak in the distance, but had no direct opposition. A real Milk Run. We were over enemy territory for an hour and ten minutes, on a four hour and forty minute flight.

Our bombardier, Lt. Ed. Cooper, was training a new togglier on this mission, Staff Sgt. J.W. Donnelly. Also, our radio operator-waist gunner, Gorchesky, was training a new man, Sgt. M.A. Sutton, so we had two new men for the day. Our navigator, Lt. Isadore Gepner, was flying with another crew on this mission, so we flew without a navigator. We stayed close to the formation through the overcast and didn't get lost, but two planes from other squadrons landed at another field.

Today, June 13, 1944, the first "Buzz Bombs" started arriving in the London area. Of our missiles on that day, only one inflicted any damage, killing six civilians and injuring nine others.
