

303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 192

25 June 1944

Target: Bridges at Sens & Coulanges-sur-Yonne, France

Crews Dispatched: 21

Length of Mission: 6 hours, 35 minutes

Bomb Load: 2 x 2,000 lb G.P. bombs

Bombing Altitudes: 20,700 & 18,000 ft

Ammo Fired: 0 rounds

The afternoon mission was to bomb a bridge at Coulanges-sur-Yonne, France, as the 41st CBW-B lead and high Groups. Two B-17s aborted the mission. #42-102453 *Princess Pat*, 358BS (Lt. **Moreau**) – The No. 2 tank ran out of fuel. The engine was feathered and couldn't be unfeathered when the Tokyo tanks were on. #42-31830 *Marie*, 359BS (Lt. **Arnold**) – VHF set failure. Both abortions were classified as personnel errors.

The 12 B-17s of the lead Group dropped 23 2,000-lb. G.P. bombs on the primary target from 20,700 feet. Results were poor – only one bomb possibly hit the bridge which was not destroyed.

The 12 Fortresses of the high Group had problems. The briefed Group and deputy Group leaders and one other aircraft never assembled with the Group. After Lt. **Moreau** had to abort and the deputy Group leader failed to assemble, 1Lt. Paul H. **Long** took over as high Group emergency leader with five other B-17s. The three 379BG aircraft scheduled to fly in the No. 4 element did not assemble and were not seen during the entire mission. Lt. **Long** was unable to form with the 41st CBW-B and joined the 41st CBW-B 384BG high Group, stacking upon their No. 2 element. When Lt. **McDevitt**, the bombardier, turned on his internal bomb rack switches, the bombs released prematurely. The right wing man (Lt. **McMillan** crew: S/Sgt. C. **Rice**, togglier) dropped on Lt. **Long's** aircraft. The left wing ship B-17 (Lt. **Bartholomew** crew: 2Lt. J.G. **Andreasen**, the bombardier) dropped on the Group leader. The remaining four 303rd BG(H) Forts dropped eight 2,000-lb. G.P. M34 bombs on a railroad bridge at Sens, France. Excellent hits were observed.

Weather had little effect on the mission. Heavy 10/10 clouds and contrails over England resulted in assembly problems, but it was clear in the target area. No enemy aircraft were seen. Friendly fighter support was good. Moderate and accurate flak was encountered at Romilly-Sur-Seine and accurate fire at Londiniere. One man was wounded by flak and all aircraft returned safely to Molesworth.

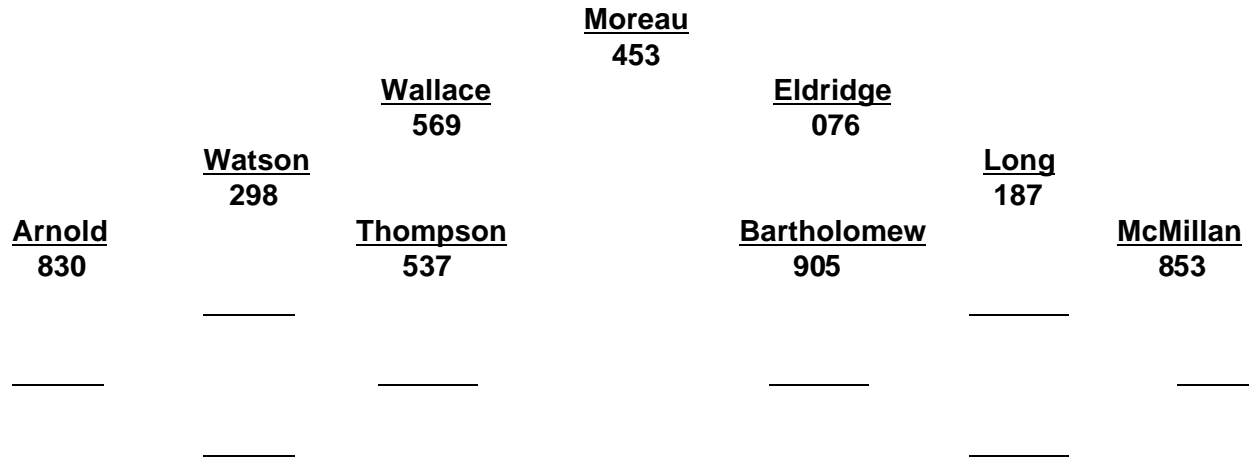
