

303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 198

7 July 1944

Target: Leipzig (Mockau), Germany

Crews Dispatched: 38

Length of Mission: 8 hours

Bomb Load: 10 x 500 lb G.P. & 10 x 500 lb Incendiary bombs

Bombing Altitudes: Group A - 24,000 ft; Group B - 23,000 ft

Ammo Fired: 0 rounds

The Group dispatched 38 B-17s as the lead and low Groups of the 41st CBW-B led by its chief of Staff, Col. William L. **Travis**. Four aircraft returned early: #42-97949 (*No Name*), 358BS (**Lee**) and #42-31830 *Marie*, 359BS (**Nafius**) - lost the formation while climbing through the clouds; #42-31405 *Wallaroo MK III*, 359BS (**Vitale**) - A row of plugs came loose, causing the engine to vibrate excessively; #42-97298 *The Floose*, 358BS (**Baker**) - reported difficulty with the prop governor.

The Group bombers dropped 160 500-lb. G.P. M43 and 180 500-lb. M17 incendiary clusters from 24,000 and 23,000 feet with uncertain results. Fortress #44-6124 (*No Name*) 360BS (Lt. **Crawford**), flew with the 390th BG and dropped ten 500-lb. incendiaries on the 390th BG target. Fortress #42-39875 *Buzz Blonde*, 427BS (Lt. **Dubose**), dropped incendiaries on Celle, Germany, a target of opportunity. Target weather was hazy with no clouds.

A few crews reported some enemy aircraft in the distance, but none attacked the 303rd BG(H) formation. Fighter support was poor and quite spotty. Intense and accurate anti-aircraft fire was experienced at the target. Seven aircraft sustained major and fourteen, minor battle damage. Two crewmen had light flak injuries. There were no casualties.



Flying aboard *Special Delivery* (A/C #42-102496), the Arnold crew barely made it back to England after receiving major battle damage during this eight-hour mission (5:28a.m.-1:30p.m.). J.J. Doyle served as co-pilot. Like the Berlin raid, the cloudless skies over Leipzig turned black from flak bursts. While over the target at 10:10a.m., one shell hit the #3 engine on the right wing. Luckily, the shell exploded just after it exited the plane, but the #3 engine was not damaged to function. After releasing their bombs at 24,000 feet, the crew dropped down to 21,000 feet probably to avoid the flak. However, they reported receiving another burst of intense flak over Merseburg at 10:15a.m. A piece of flak hit John Surrell's oxygen mask and knocked him four or five feet forward from his tail gunner position into a crawl space. Surrell was uninjured except for a chipped

tooth and a small cut under one eye. Meanwhile, the #4 generator and #2 supercharger were knocked out.

The crew then began a long and difficult trip home aboard a badly damaged plane that could no longer keep up with the rest of the formation. The mechanical problems caused the flaps and wheels to drift down. Several times the crew was forced to hand-crank them back into position. Fortunately, some US P-38 fighters kept an eye on *Special Delivery* during at least part of the two-hour trip to the north coast of Germany. Desperate to keep the plane airborne, Arnold ordered the crew to throw out any extra gear to lighten the load. The crew jettisoned the waist gun, extra ammunition and their flak suits.

By the time they were over the North Sea, all of the plane's generators were out, leaving them with no electrical system. Arnold decided to land at the closest US airbase they could find in England. As they landed at Alconbury, gasoline began spewing out from the damaged #3 tank. The pressure in the self-sealing tank dropped when the speed of the plane was reduced. The Arnold crew, expecting the fuel to ignite at any moment, jumped out of the plane when they came to a stop. They ran into a field adjacent to the runway and waited for the anticipated explosion. After nothing happened for a while, they walked back over to the plane to examine the damage. *Special Delivery* had so many holes from the flak that it looked like a sieve. Stanley Claster estimated 80-100 holes.

The base commander personally debriefed the crew. He was amazed John Surrell was unhurt despite the extensive damage to the plane's tail area. After the debriefing, the Arnold team saw *Special Delivery* lying with its belly on the runway because the landing gears had collapsed. The crew spent the night at the base and returned to Molesworth by truck the next day. Eighth Air Force records indicate that *Special Delivery* was one of seven B-17s that received major battle damage out of the 34 planes from the 303rd Bombardment Group that bombed on this mission. All the planes returned safely to England. Remarkably, *Special Delivery* was repaired and flew on missions until the end of the war.
