

# 303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 212

25 July 1944

Target: "Operation Cobra" German Troop Centers  
and Concentrations west of St. Lo, France

Crews Dispatched: 39

Length of Mission: 4 hours, 50 minutes

Bomb Load: 38 x 100 lb M1A1 Fragmentation bombs

Bombing Altitudes: 14,000 & 13,300 ft

Ammo Fired: 0 rounds

**A** second tactical air strike to support the US 1st Army was flown by 37 303rd BG(H) B-17s forming the 41 CBW-A. No aircraft returned early.

In the target area there were 7/10 to 8/10 altostratus and altocumulus clouds with a 15,000 ft. base. Visibility was restricted to eight to ten miles in haze and smoke. The lead and low Groups dropped a total of 1,046 100-lb. M1A1 fragmentation bombs on their assigned targets. Photographs indicated poor results. The high Group did not bomb because it could not positively identify the target and because it was cut off by other Groups on the bomb run. No enemy aircraft were seen and anti-aircraft was only observed. Friendly fighter support was good. There were no casualties.

The 8th Air Force tried to enforce strict procedures to avoid short bombing on US troops, as on July 24, but it happened again, with an even greater loss of life. A B-24 lead bombardier failed to synchronize his bomb sight when making a visual release and 470 100-lb. bombs hit the US lines. Eleven other B-24s dropped 352 260-lb. fragmentation bombs in the same general area as the first bombing mistake. This bombardier failed to properly identify the target when he mistook gun flashes for the red artillery smoke markers. Another instance occurred when a command pilot, under the impression that bombing was by Wings rather than Groups, ordered bombs released when the bombardier was still attempting to locate the target. A total of 102 army personnel were killed, including Lt. Gen. Leslie J. **McNair**, and 380 were wounded. T/5 John K. **Lester**, a Jeep driver for the 29th Field Artillery, 4th Infantry Division, later wrote:

On July 25, 1944, the 4th Division spearheaded the St. Lo breakthrough. The 8th Infantry Regiment, supported by the 29th Field Artillery, was the attacking force. Well over 2000 heavy bombers flew over to bomb 1000 yards ahead of the infantry. I was at an observation post and could observe much of the activity. I hadn't seen as many planes since "D-Day." The first waves of bombers were on target but, the heavy cloud of smoke started drifting back over the infantry and, then the bombers started dropping their bombs on our own troops. Many of our infantry were killed, wounded, and stunned by this terrible error but, the attack went on as planned. I don't know how they did it under those conditions.... Some of the bombs that were dropped short, landed close to our observation post. I believe Lt. General Leslie J. McNair was killed by one such bomb not too far from my location. If I remember right, he was standing by a knocked out German tank about 100 yards from me. I saw at least four of our B-24 bombers fall out of the sky. Two of them were breaking apart as they fell. What an awesome sight. The Germans had put up plenty of anti-aircraft fire.
