

## 303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 213

28 July 1944

Target: Leuna Synthetic Oil Plant, Merseburg, Germany

Crews Dispatched: 37

Length of Mission: 7 hours, 50 minutes

Bomb Load: 10 x 500 lb M43 bombs

Bombing Altitudes: 26,200, 25,200 & 24,200 ft

Ammo Fired: 0 rounds

**T**hirty-seven 303rd BG(H) aircraft, plus two 305BG PFF B-17s, departed Molesworth to bomb the Leuna synthetic oil plant at Merseburg, Germany. Aircraft of the 303rd BG(H) flew as the 41st CBW-A which was led by Lt. Col. William R. **Calhoun**. No aircraft returned early.

Thirty-seven aircraft dropped 370 500-lb. M43 bombs. PFF bombing was utilized and results could not be observed. In the target area, there were 8/10 to 9/10 altostratus clouds with tops at 16,000 ft., with 3/10 to 4/10 tops of swelling cumulus extending to 20,000 ft. with occasional tops at 23,000 ft.

No enemy aircraft was spotted. Moderate to intense and fairly accurate flak was encountered in the target area, and meager and fairly accurate fire at Zeitz. Two aircraft sustained major and eight, minor battle damage.

**JULY 28, 1944, MERSEBURG, GERMANY**  
from the book "25 Milk Runs" by Richard R. "Dick" Johnson

Today's mission would take us keep into Germany to the Luena Oil Works at Merseburg, the most heavily defended city in Germany, where strong enemy resistance is always encountered. My second new crew was going with me in the B-17 named "*Betty Jane*" that I had flown several times before, including the glide bomb attack on Cologne.

This morning the 303rd Bomb Group put up 37 aircraft, taking off between the hours of 0550 and 0619 to make assembly over the Harrington buncher at 9,000 feet. Each B-17 was carrying ten, five hundred pound bombs.

During assembly my aircraft was approached by another B-17 which caused me to fly a 360 degree turn to stay out of his way. By the time I returned to the assembly area, the 303rd Group was too far ahead for me to catch up, so I latched onto the 379th out of Kimbolton which I knew was going to the same target. Many pilots aborted when they couldn't find their group and I didn't want this stigma attached to me. Had I not known the destination of the 379th, I would have had no choice but to abort. I could have climbed steeply, or dived to get away from the intruding B-17, but being heavily loaded, this would put undue stress on the wings and tail, so I chose to circle.

My new co-pilot for the day was J.A. Drewry with all his crew, except his co-pilot who was flying with yet another experienced pilot.

During this mission the 303rd saw no enemy fighters, but the 379th that I was flying with encountered a few. Our top turret gunner, Sgt. E.H. Koch fired at an FW-190 that seemed to be trying to drag a bomb on a long wire through our formation. That bomb didn't explode and Koch didn't seem to hit the FW-190 who was about three thousand feet above us flying in the same direction. The fighters were not pressing any attacks for some reason not clear to me unless they were waiting to see the big explosion that never came. There were no P-51s in the immediate area, so we should have been attacked. We encountered flak at seven different locations on this mission, but the "*Betty Jane*" only suffered two minor flak wounds on this trip.

We had been discharging chaff to foil the German radar and it seemed to do some good. The target was overcast, so the German gunners could not sight visually, nor could we bomb visually. Most of the heavy concentration of flak seemed to always be behind us.

Evidently we didn't do such a good job on the synthetic oil plant, as we later learned that we would go back to the same target tomorrow.

Our flight time was eight hours and ten minutes, with four hours and twenty minutes over enemy territory.

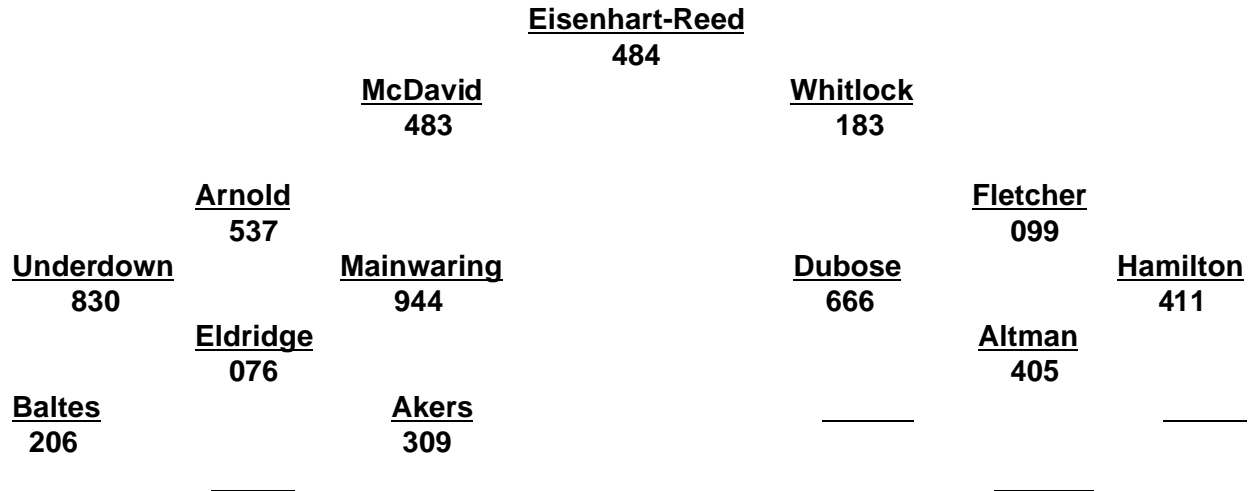
