

## 303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 271

10 November 1944

Target: Ostheim Airfield and Butzweilerhof Airfield  
Cologne, Germany

Crews Dispatched: 52

Crews Lost: Lt. Boulter, 2 KIA, 7 POW

Length of Mission: 7 hours, 15 minutes

Bomb Load: 38 x 100 lb H.E. M43 bombs

Bombing Altitudes: 27,400 & 26,600; 26,700 & 26,200

Ammo Fired: 12,500 rounds

**T**wo separate Groups of bombers were dispatched to attack airfields in the Cologne area from which German jet propelled reconnaissance airplanes were operating.

Lt. Col. **Cole's** 41st CBW-A Group attacked the Cologne/Ostheim airfield from 26,700 and 26,200 feet. In the target area there were 8/10 to 9/10 low clouds with tops at 16,000 to 20,000 feet and 4/10 middle clouds with tops at 18,000 feet. Aircraft dropped 891 100-lb. H.E. M43 bombs and 10 leaflets bundles. Bombing was GEE-H with unobserved results.

Captain Jack W. **Riseden's** 41st CBW-D Group attacked the nearby Cologne-Butzweilerhof field from 27,400 and 26,600 feet. Cloud cover was almost identical to that experienced by the 41st CBW-A with GEE-H bombing. Results, again, were unobserved. Some crews reported smoke rising from the target area. The aircraft dropped 894 100-lb. bombs and 10 leaflet bundles. Aircraft #42-97546 *Idaliza*, 360BS (Lt **Gravrock**), returned early when his aircraft developed mechanical problems.

Air support was provided by 182 P-51s and no enemy aircraft were seen. Both formations encountered intense and accurate flak over the targets. Battle damage on returning aircraft was:

41 CBW-A: Major-7 A/C	Minor-15 A/C	1 man wounded

#43-38442 (*No Name*), 358BS piloted by 1Lt. Walter J. **Mayer**, had a harrowing experience that was concluded with a miraculous forced landing at St. Trond, Belgium. Lt. **Mayer** described the mission conclusion as follows:

The air speed indicator was lost on take-off, so we flew on basic instruments with the formation. At 26,000 feet on the bomb run, the aircraft was hit by intense flak and lost two engines. Though severely damaged, we dropped the bombs and tried to stay with the formation. We lost altitude and decided to make an emergency landing at P-47 base in St. Trond, Belgium. Unable to make radio contact with the Base, and with two engines out, no air speed indicator, and gas from the ruptured tank flowing from the right wing, we made the turn to let down and fired flares. The thick, bullet-proof windshield iced up badly during rapid descent and the nose plexiglass also iced up. Since P-47s were taking off on a scramble from the active runway, our crippled B-17 approached an alternate parking runway. The toggler and navigator, crouched in the aisle between the pilot and co-pilot, spotted a steam roller on the end of the runway through the bombsight glass. With my head out the open window, I bounced the plane over the steam roller and lost my mission crunch flight hat. The prop of a P-51 parked halfway down the runway, its nose toward the center, sliced off the end of our B-17's right wing. With a speed of about 15-20 MPH, our B-17 crashed into the middle of a B-24 parked at the end of the runway, almost cutting it in half. The crew immediately evacuated the plane while fire crews poured on the foam. Prior to impact, I advised Lt. **Gradle** to cut the master switch. I later learned the B-24 had just been loaded with 1,000 gallons of fuel. While writing the catastrophe statement, an irate P-51 pilot, whose plane now needed an engine change among other things, confronted me. The Belgian steam roller operator thoughtfully returned my hat. The crew sustained no major injuries, but scratch one B-17, one P-51 and one B-24.

Fortress #42-31830 *Marie*, 359BS, piloted by 1Lt. Raymond A. **Boulter**, in the 41st CBW-A lead Squadron, suffered two direct flak hits over the target, near Cologne. The No. 3 engine and right wheel were knocked off and the side panels above the bomb bay and wings were blown off. When hit, it peeled off to the right and went down in a moderately steep dive, partially under control, with the No. 3 engine nacelle on fire. Three bodies were seen leaving the Fortress, but no parachutes were seen to open. Lt. **Boulter** and T/Sgt. Lewis P. **Ficken** were killed in the crash. T/Sgt. **Ficken** is buried in Netherlands American Cemetery, Martgratten, Netherlands. 2Lt. Arthur F. **Perry**, 2Lt. James M. **Craven**, T/Sgt. Glen R. **Wyly**, T/Sgt. Harold P. **McKelvey**, T/Sgt. Carl E. **Frymoyer**, S/Sgt. Joseph J. **Sanzone** and S/Sgt. Stanley **Finch** survived the crash, were captured and became POWs.
