

303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 285

11 December 1944

Target: Railroad Bridge at Mannheim, Germany

Crews Dispatched: 52

Length of Mission: 8 hours, 10 minutes

Bomb Load: 2 x 1,000 H.E. M44 & 2 x 2,000 lb H.E. M34 bombs

Bombing Altitudes: 21,600, 21,700, 22,400 & 23,000 ft

Ammo Fired: 1,200 rounds

The largest fleet of four-engine bombers ever assembled raided western Germany's rail centers. Crews totaled 15,900 men and their aircraft formed a column over 100 miles long. The B-17s and B-24s were supported by 755 P-51s and 86 P-47s.

On this mission the 303rd BG(H) dispatched the second largest number of B-17s during WWII. Ground crews labored long hours to prepare 52 aircraft. Four aircraft returned early: #44-8439 (*No Name*), 360BS (LtCol. **Shayler**) – internal failure of the supercharger; #42-38050 *Thunderbird*, 359BS (Lt. **Harding**) – mid-air collision; #42-31060 (*No Name*), 427BS (Lt. **Turnisky**) – waist gunner anoxia; #43-38258 *Forget Me Not Olly*, 358BS, (Lt. **Bixby**, 359BS) – runaway prop.

When Lt. Col. **Shayler** aborted, the 41st CBW-A leader became 1Lt. G.H. **Fielder** of the low Squadron. The 360BS lead formation became the high Squadron under the command of 1Lt. M.C. **Butler**.

The mission was uneventful. No enemy fighters were spotted and friendly fighter support by 167 1st BD P-51s was good. Anti-aircraft fire at the target was accurate, but moderate, and chaff was quite effective. There were no casualties and two aircraft had some minor damage.

Group bombers dropped 84 1,000-lb. H.E. M44 and 90 2,000-lb. H.E. M34 bombs on the primary target from 21,600, 21,700 and 23,000 feet. Weather at the target was 8/10 to 10/10 high clouds with bases at 23,000 to 24,000 feet, 7/10 to 9/10 middle clouds with tops at 19,200 feet, and dense, persistent contrails at 22,000 feet and up. Results from the GEE-H bombing were unobserved.

BOMBING BY THE SEAT OF YOUR PANTS

We were the deputy lead to lead crew, Lt/Col. Shayler, the CO of the 360th Bomb Squadron. He had to abort due to supercharger problems, leaving the 360th Squadron at low altitude (approximately 10,000 ft) and all alone half way across France. The remainder of the Group had reformed on another Squadron and climbed on to bombing altitude (22,000 feet) and had gone out of sight.

Our navigator was on his 2nd or 3rd mission, and we didn't have any navigation aids (radio, Gee, etc) except winds given at briefing, and only a bombsight for visual bombing. We continued on a dead reckoning course to the initial point (IP) and having reached bombing altitude turned on the bomb run to target as determined by our navigator.

We had 11 aircraft in the formation, but we were all alone in the sky. It was 10/10 undercast, 10/10 overcast, clear and visibility unlimited at our altitude (approximately 15,000 feet to 30,000 feet). No other aircraft (ours or the Germans) could be seen. No flak — nothing but a beautiful layer of clouds below and above. We knew they were there, we just couldn't see any other aircraft around.

We flew around over what we thought was Mannheim, looking for a break in the clouds or some means to bomb, but there was none. We turned on a northwest heading to go home and eventually saw another group of B-17s coming in on a east, northeast heading and we decided to fall in behind them and drop on their smoke markers.

I wasn't about to fly into the middle of Germany in a 11 plane formation, with no escorts, and then return to base with the bombs in their racks and get no credit for the mission. Before we reached them, they began to receive flak and then they dropped their bombs. Two planes went down in flames as we watched from a distance of approximately 7 to 8 miles.

I directed my pilot, Lt Butler, to turn and head for the smoke markers as they would break up soon. I tried to toggle our bombs to go through the clouds at the smoke markers. Flak came up along the previous group's course, but stopped before we reached the markers. We turned and came home by dead reckoning navigation. I feel we hit Frankfurt due to heading and flak concentration.

The memorable part of this mission was the panorama of a B-17 group flying into a box of flak, dropping their load of bombs, one plane blowing up and dropping in large pieces of fire. Another with an engine on fire, pulling out of formation as the group flew out of the box of flak, all of this right in front of us, as this group passed across our path.

After turning toward the smoke markers and without getting to their flight path, the flak began to come up again but was tracking along the previous group's flight path. This put us on a collision course that would terminate at the smoke markers.

It was a little unnerving to sit in my "green house" and watch as the box of intense flak came closer to surrounding us, but just before we reached the markers, the flak stopped and we dropped our bombs and turned to clear the area without any flak in our Squadron.

I've always assumed that the bombs from the group ahead of us was striking the ground and caused the gunners to seek bomb shelter.

Lt/Col's Cole and Shayler were waiting to see us as soon as we landed. Lt. Butler received the DFC (Distinguished Flying Cross) and I received a sarcastic remark from Acting CO, Colonel Cole for dropping on a different heading.

MID AIR COLLISION OF THUNDERBIRD

B-17G #42-38050 *Thunderbird* 359BS (BN-U) , piloted by 2Lt Lawrence T. **Harding** aborted this mission due to a mid-air collision. There are very few details of this accident and the other B-17 involved is not known. The mission report contains a handwritten memo dated 11 Dec 44 by Lt Harding that reads:

"Aircraft: 42-38050. Takeoff: 0830 hours. Turned around: 1130 Hours (27,000' Altitude). Time of return: 1514 hours. Prop No. 4 engine hit lower part of man flying on the other wing. We dumped our nose and were in the clouds. When we pulled out could not find formation. Turned back at 49 degrees 10 minutes North - 07 degrees 30 minutes East. Bombs were jettisoned at 50 degrees 20 minutes North - 01 degrees 30 Minutes East."
