

303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 332

8 March 1945

Target: Benzol Plant at Essen, Germany

Crews Dispatched: 39

Length of Mission: 6 hours, 17 minutes

Bomb Load: 12 x 500 lb H.E. M43 & 2 x 500 lb M17 Incendiaries

Bombing Altitudes: 25,000, 24,000 & 25,700 ft

Ammo Fired: 450 rounds

Effective today, according to an Eighth Air Force Directive, targets would no longer be referred to as primary, secondary and last resort. New designations will be first, second, third, etc. in order of priority.

The first two priority targets were the Benzol plant at Essen visually (first), or by GEE-H (second). The third and fourth were the marshalling yard at Essen visually (third) and H2X (fourth).

One aircraft returned early — #43-38238 (*No Name*), 358BS (Lt. **Nester**). The No. 2 turbo failed and the aircraft jettisoned six bombs over the Channel. The oil line in the No. 4 engine broke and the prop was feathered. Over the Channel, on the route back, the No.

2 engine caught fire. The fire was put out and the prop feathered. The B-17 arrived over England at 5,000 feet and the crew sighted the Seething airfield (448BS/2AD). Two landing approaches were made. The runway could not be reached on the second approach and a wheels-up crash landing was made in a clearing short and to the left of the runway between two patches of woods. The B-17 was badly damaged, but the pilot and two other crewmen sustained only very minor injuries.

443 500-lb. H.E. M43, 70 500-lb. M17 incendiary bombs, and 10 units of leaflets on the second priority target by GEE-H through a solid undercast. In the target area, there were 10/10 low clouds with tops at 6,000 feet and no contrails at bombing altitude. Results could not be observed, but were believed to have been good.

Thirty-eight aircraft dropped

There was no enemy opposition, friendly fighter support by 93 P-51s was good, and only meager flak was observed at the target. There was no battle damage or casualties and all aircraft returned safely to Molesworth. F/O John H. Magner (N) flew with Chelveston in PFF B-17G #44-8238.

Lt. Walter H. McDonald, Navigator on the Lt. Harry D. Gobrecht crew, flying in the 358BS B-17G #43-37590, *Neva-The Silver Lady*, reported the following:

We came off our bomb run with over 90 holes in our plane, one engine feathered and most of our instruments not in working order. As the formation flew off to the north we lagged further and further behind, until finally we were all alone — a perfect target for German fighters. I could navigate by pilotage for awhile, but we soon flew over an overcast and the ground wasn't visible. After what seemed an eternity, I saw a slight break in the clouds below. On the ground I could get a glimpse of a narrow strip of land. Knowing what part of Europe we were in, I realized that this could only be the dam holding the ocean water out of the Zuider Zee. Giving Lt. Gobrecht the new heading for Molesworth, we arrived as the first B-17 to land. The rest of the formation had been on a zig-zag "Cook's Tour" of Europe to confuse German radar.

The photographs below may be the best documented photographs of 303rd B-17s on a bombing mission. The first photograph shows the 358th BS Lead Formation approaching the target in heavy flak. The second photograph shows them at Bombs Away. The two smaller photographs are the key to identify the aircraft. The photographs were taken from 358BS B-17G #43-39096 *Sky Demon* (VK-M), flown by 2Lt Charles E. Garrett (P) and F/O Joseph L. Castillo (CP).




APPROACHING THE TARGET
