### 358th Bombardment Squadron

303rd Bombardment Group (H) Molesworth, England 1942-1945

The 358th Bombardment Squadron Ground Echelon arrived at Molesworth, England on 12 September 1942, and joined the other Squadrons in trying to get the operation moving without any materials or equipment. But soon, things started arriving and the B-17's began to appear. The original aircraft were: Hell's Angels, Sky Wolf, Hunga Dunga, Hellcat, Jersey Bounce, Spook, One O'Clock Jump, Leapin Liz and Werewolf.

These aircraft were a matter of pride to the men on the ground, and they worked around the clock to prepare them for the next day's raid. Several of the 358th Bomb Squadron ground echelon distinguished themselves. M/Sgt Carino Colancecco, M/Sgt Fabian S. Folmer, M/Sgt Everett W. Emery, and M/Sgt William C. Woodman were awarded the Legion of Merit for

their outstanding job of getting their Fortresses in the air when they were so badly needed. In addition, several men in the Squadron were awarded the Bronze Star Medal for meritorious service after putting in long hours in all kinds of weather to make certain that their planes could fly the next day.

The Squadron's first Commanding Officer was Major Clemens K. Wurzbach, who was a West Pointer and went on to become a Colonel in Command of another Bomb Group. He was succeeded by Major Kirk R. Mitchell, who lead the 358th on some of their roughest bombing missions.

Major George T. Mackin succeeded Major Mitchell on 30 March 1944 and served until he completed his tour in January 1945. Major Glynn F. Shumake commanded the Squadron until he was shot down and became MIA and a POW on Mission #248 to

POW on Mission #348 to

Bremen, on March 30, 1945. The Squadron was temporarily commanded by Captain Willard H. Bergeron until Major Robert M. Nye was given command. He served until the war was over in May 1945.

The organization of the 358th Bombardment Squadron followed the normal Table of Organization for Army Air Force Units. This coverage of the Squadron will concentrate on the Ground Support Personnel, as the air echelon will be covered many times in the individual write-ups of the separate missions flown by the 358th. The major functions were S-1 (Personnel); S-2

(Intelligence); S-3 (Operations); and S-4 (Maintenance & Supply). There were several supporting functions that included the Adjutant, Communications, Armament, Ordnance, Chemical, Transportation and Utilities.
