303rd Bombardment Group (H) Molesworth, England 1942-1945

The 359th Bombardment Squadron Ground Echelon arrived at Molesworth, England on 12 September 1942, and joined the other Squadrons in trying to get the operation moving without any materials or equipment. But soon, things started arriving and the B-17s began to appear. The original aircraft were: *Green Hornet, Holy Mackerel, Idaho Potato Peeler, Knockout Dropper, Lady Fairweather, The Duchess; The "8" Ball,* Yehudi and *Zombie.*

These aircraft were a matter of pride to the men on the ground, and they worked around the clock to prepare them for the next day's raid. M/Sgt Buford G. Pafford was awarded the Legion of Merit for his outstanding

performance as Crew Chief of the *Knockout Dropper*, which was the first B-17 to complete 50 and 75 missions over enemy territory. M/Sgt Thomas F. Westmoreland and T/Sgt Joseph B. Strange were awarded the Bronze Star for meritorious service after putting in long hours, in all kinds of weather to make certain that their planes could fly the next day.


The organization of the 359th Bombardment Squadron followed the normal Table of Organization for Army Air Force Units. The major functions were S-1 (Personnel); S-2 (Intelligence); S-3 (Operations); and S-4 (Maintenance & Supply). There were several supporting functions that included the Adjutant, Communications, Armament, Ordnance, Chemical, Transportation and Utilities.

Everyone on Molesworth was dedicated to the success of the mission, and all personnel serving in the Ground Support Echelon set high standards to make sure that all the required tasks were performed in a timely manner.

One of the Crew Chief's of the 359th Bombardment Squadron, T/Sgt James C. Hicks, who was the Asst Crew Chief of *The Duchess* and Crew Chief of the *Queen of Hearts*, has some significant words to say about the Ground Support Echelon in his story, "What I See When I Look at a B-17." He wrote:

As I think about the B-17 today, I see people, as they were the ones that made everything tick. Whether it was the mail clerk, the GI can scrubber, the one on KP, the orderly room clerks, and I can't begin to mention all the other jobs being done, and then there were all the supporting units and their people. All of these people went together to make up the organization of the 303rd Bomb Group. Our success

was because each person did his job. No matter whether the job seemed small or whatever, it had to be done. Some knew absolutely nothing about the "plane" on that parking pad, not unlike the squadron carpenter and by the same token, those on the pad probably didn't know about the squadron carpenters job either, but both jobs had to be done and this made the victory. It was the family, as a Squadron. The family as a Group, the family as Molesworth, Station 107, with all of the necessary components, in whatever it needed to do the job, and we took pride in doing it well. And for the outstanding job that these people have done, they shall forever, with considerable pride, hold their heads high for the rest of their lives.
